

CELL C INNOVATION EXPO 2020

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

THE CHALLENGE

Cell C is looking for participants to submit innovative business ideas relevant to the ICT field, which make use of data, offer a unique solution, are commercially viable and scaleable (the "**Challenge**"). As part of Reskilling within Cell C, the Challenge is also opened to Cell C employees who are affected by the restructure. The Challenge is not open for senior managers but strictly for those D3 to B salary band employees whose jobs have been made redundant due to operational requirements.

RULES

- 1. The participant must be:
 - a. (i) a South African resident who is 18 years or older and in possession of a valid South

African Identity Document (ii) be a juristic person established in South Africa; and



- be of sound and sober attributes with no criminal record or impending criminal cases.
- c. EME/ QSE verification is deemed mandatory for purposes of this application process.
- In order for the application to be considered the beneficiaries would need to be at least
 51% black owned
- The application must be completed fully and accurately, with all the relevant documentation required.
- If participant is a Cell C employee, he/she must provide employee number and department within Cell C.
- 4. The participant must have an innovative idea/solution within the ICT sector and be able to present such idea through a business plan together with budgets, forecasts and needs analysis.
- 5. By entering the Challenge, participants agree to travel to a destination within South Africa, as determined by Cell C, to present his/her/its idea to the panel of judges (the "Panel") should he/she/it proceed to the final leg of the Challenge.
- 6. The Start-Up Package which will be awarded to the successful participants (the **"Approved"**), will be determined by the Panel, at its sole and absolute discretion, taking into account the motivation presented by the Approved as part of his/her/its proposal during the final round of judging and what the Panel believes is the support required in order to realise and implement the approved idea.
- 7. The Start-Up Package will comprise of one of the below or a combination of inter alia the following:
 - a. a. start-up/operating capital in the form of a unsecured loan/ standard loan; and
 - b. b. partnership agreement with Cell C to realise and implement the approved idea;
 - c. c. Business support to turn the idea into a product/ solution;



- d. d. Business support to scale the business;
- e. e. Potentially become a supplier in the Cell C supply chain
- 8. The Start-Up Package which the Approved will receive as well as the value of each component of the Start-Up Package will be determined by Cell C in conjunction with the Panel in its sole and absolute discretion. No minimum amount is guaranteed.
- 9. The Approved may be required to enter into an agreement with Cell C:
 - a. in terms of which Cell C will partner with the Approved and may acquire rights in the approved idea/products/solutions;
 - b. in terms of which the approved idea will be realised and implemented;
 - c. dealing with the awarding and implementation of the Start-up Package and any ancillary matters thereto; and/or
 - d. any other matter(s) which Cell C, in its sole and absolute discretion, may incorporate in respect of the agreement.
- 10. Cell C reserves the right to terminate this Challenge with immediate effect before the end of the challenge period at any time, if deemed necessary in its sole and absolute discretion and/or if circumstances arise which are outside of Cell C's control. No participant will have any claim against Cell C for such a termination.
- 11. Participation in the Challenge constitutes automatic acceptance of these terms and conditions and the participant agrees to abide by these terms and conditions. In the event that a participant is a juristic person, that participant warrants that it is duly authorised to enter into the Challenge.
- **12.** Cell C does not make any representations or give any warranties, whether express or implied, that the Participant's participation in this Challenge will necessarily result in the Participant



receiving a cash incentive. Cash incentives will not be awarded for

participation in this Challenge.

- 13. To the extent permissible in law, Cell C is not responsible and cannot be held liable for any accident, injury, harm, death, loss or damages of whatsoever nature, howsoever arising, as a result of the participant's participation in the Challenge.
- 14. Participants including Cell C employees as explained above are obliged to comply with all applicable laws, including those laws protecting the intellectual property rights of other parties.
- 15. These terms and conditions will be construed, interpreted, governed and enforced in terms of South African law.
